Junior Category – Grades 6, 7, 8

- **Who?**
Open to students in grades 6, 7, and 8
- **What?**
Students in groups of 2-5 people film a 2 minute video answering the topic question. A 250 word write-up can also be included to explain the video.
- **Prize**
The winning group will receive a class visit by a volunteer who has worked in Africa and prizes from Mountain Equipment Coop

Intermediate Category – Grades 9, 10, 11

- **Who?**
Open to students in grades 9, 10, 11
- **What?**

Students work independently to create a photo essay depicting their vision of a better world. The essay can consist of up to five photos, and each photograph can be accompanied by a 75 word caption.

- **Prize**
The student with the winning entry will receive a personalized video from a volunteer who has worked in Africa and prizes from Mountain Equipment Coop

Senior Category – Grade 12

- **Who?**
Open to students in grade 12
- **What?**
Students Write a 500-word essay answering the question “What kind of world do you want to live in and what will it take to get there?”.
- **Prize**
The student with the winning essay will receive a \$1500 scholarship for post-secondary studies and prizes from Mountain Equipment Coop
